TIMING	• The risk for wildfire spread will be highest from mid afternoon to sunset.
	• Winds: From the northwest at 10-20 mph with gusts up to 25 mph.

Relative Humidity: Decreasing into the 20-30% range across much of central PA **HAZARD** • <u>Isolated Dry Thunderstorms:</u> A few storms may develop the potential to produce lightning, but with little or no rain. The greatest risk for dry thunderstorms is east of I-99 and Route 15. **Dry Fuels**

• A Red Flag Warning is in effect through this evening for Central and Eastern PA.

A Special Weather Statement is in effect for Western PA.
